Reginald Avenue RAP Road Reconstruction Project Update #3 (June 23, 2024)



Project Overview

The Reginald Avenue Recycled Asphalt Pavement (RAP) delivery is progressing well. It will be necessary to extend the Laurier Street stockpile further west between Haliburton Ave. and Mount Royal Ave. to stockpile SP#1b. Vehicle access will be provided to acreages with gates in this location. RAP hauling will continue throughout the summer and should be completed mid-August. Truck haul routes and stockpile locations are shown on Figure #1 on the back side of this update. Empty trucks will exit on Haliburton or Mount Royal Ave.

Stockpile location SP#1b was selected because of its location, easy truck access and to reduce project cost. Laurier Street remediation includes future plans for a RAP walkway or narrow road. By bundling the Reginald Ave. and Laurier Street projects together, costs will be minimized and it will provide the best value to the community. When the project is awarded in March 2025, more details will be provided to residents. Visit the website (www.furdale.net) for all project updates and current information.

- June 13 Strip topsoil at stockpile location SP#1a and begin hauling RAP
- June 24 Strip topsoil at stockpile location SP#1b and continue hauling RAP
- Mid-August Complete hauling RAP

2025 Project Schedule

- January Tender project
- March Award project
- Summer Complete project (approx. 2-4 weeks)
- Complete RAP walkway or narrow road on Laurier Street
